Conclusion


At present there is only one potential therapy in the horizon that can reduce progression of the disease, but not stop, in the upper part of the body

We need to increase our effort towards understanding the pathobiology of the disease, thereby, increasing prospect of finding an effective therapy

Meanwhile, we need to keep working towards developing gene and cell based therapies, and small molecule screens, that do not require understanding of the disease.

We also need to find ways to make the drugs accessible to everyone in the world

Patient organisations, such as NDF and WWGM could bring all stakeholders in the quest for finding a cure available to everyone.
